Nigel Heath - Animation Filmography

Nigel has worked on countless animation projects in his career to date and understands the specific needs for animation sound.

He has worked on music and sound design 'proof of concepts' for three ground-breaking series from one of the world's leading animation studios

As lead sound designer and re-recording mixer of ITV Studios/Pukeko Pictures 'Thunderbirds Are Go', Nigel was trusted with the sympathetic restyling and updating of the sounds for the legendary Thunderbird craft as well as being responsible for the overall sound content of the entire state of the art 78 part series.

Nigel was sound supervisor and co-sound designer on series one of 'Robozuna' from Kidscave and ITV Studios for Netflix. This series saw the use of many unique and highly sound techniques. He was also lead mixer on the series and adapted the series sounds for the toy range based on the characters and vehicles featured in the show.

In 2019 he sound supervised and mixed 'Firestorm' produced by Jamie Anderson out of Anderson Entertainment. The show, a mixture of CG and live action imagery, was directed by visual FX supremo Steve Begg.

His association with sound for animation goes back to the days of Gerald Scarfe's animated 35mm triptych projections for Pink Floyd's 'The Wall' live shows, where he was a junior in the sound team. This led to him working on the first of many productions with Sir Paul McCartney, 'We All Stand Together' where Nigel recorded custom sound effects for the short film which was centred on the popular song.

Nigel has worked with a host of animation directors including: Will Vinton, Geoff Dunbar, Diane Jackson, Ed Bignell, Steve Majuary, Karl Essex, Theo Baynton, Paul Vester, Bob Godfrey, Grange Calveley, Annabel Jankel & Rocky Morton, Marjut Rimminen, David Anderson, Jack Stokes, Mike Stuart, Dave Unwin, Roger Mainwood, David Scott and the team at Pukeko in New Zealand working with Peter Jackson's WETA Workshop.

He worked on the first iteration of the famous 'stuttering' dialogue for 'Max Headroom' involving some painstaking cutting up of magnetic tape and the use a lot of sticky tane!

FIFA called on Nigel and his crew to provide sound editorial, design and mixing for 'Spheriks' a major 26 part action packed animation series based on the adventures of the 2002 World Cup mascots.

In 2005 Nigel was part of the sound team on the 'Magic Roundabout' movie directed by Frank Passingham and Aardman's 'Wallace And Gromit In The Curse Of The Wererabbit'

2008 saw a nomination for a 'US Mix Foundation Award' in the category of 'Outstanding Creative Achievement In Feature Film Sound Mixing' for his dialogue work on Pixar's 'Ratatouille' with director Brad Bird.

The large scale exhibition opened in Singapore in 2018 and toured the 'States with the next venues awaiting announcement at the time of writing.

'The Circle Of Remembrance 'with multichannel sound inserts co mixed by Nigel, was broadcast live worldwide and featured a huge multichannel immersive sound experience in the 20,000 capacity O2 Dome in London.

Other notable installations he has worked on include '100 Objects To Represent The World' which was staged in Vienna, 'Stairs 1' in Geneva, 'Flying Over Water' in Malmo and the Louvre Museum Paris and the spectacular sound and light show 'Roma' in the Piazza Del Popolo in Rome – all these latter exhibitions being the brainchild of film director Peter Greenaway.
